Bill: HCR 2 - Concurrent Resolution Directing PEHP Regarding Pharmaceutical Rebates

This Resolution directs the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program to give the estimated value of pharmaceutical rebates to state plan members at the point of sale.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Resolution. There was no discussion.

Outcome: HCR 2 passed the 3^{rd} reading in the House and will be sent to the Senate to be signed by the President.

Bill: SB 13 – Property Tax Reimbursement Amendments

This Bill provides for reimbursement of property taxes.

Discussion: The Sponsor presented the Bill. The House adopted Amendment 1. The amendment changes county "auditors" to county "assessors" throughout the Bill. No discussion ensued.

Outcome: SB 13, as amended, passed out of the House, and will be sent to the Senate to concur with the amendment.

Bill: 1st substitute HB 66 – Ritual Abuse Amendments

Sponsor: Representative Ken Ivory

Floor Sponsor:

UASD Position: Support

This Bill addresses ritual abuse.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. The House adopted Amendment 1. The amendment deletes the additional training requirement for the Utah Prosecution Council to develop on lines

44-46 and adds language to line 59 stating that the advanced training course must include "identifying indicators of a ritual abuse...in cases of sexual assault". There was no discussion to the Bill.

Outcome: 1st substitute HB 66, as amended, passed out of the House, and will be sent to the Senate to concur with the amendment.
