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### **Bill: HCR 2 – Concurrent Resolution Directing PEHP Regarding Pharmaceutical Rebates**

**UASD Position: Tracking**

This Resolution directs the Public Employees' Benefit and Insurance Program to give the estimated value of pharmaceutical rebates to state plan members at the point of sale.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Resolution. There was no discussion.

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### **Bill: SB 13 – Property Tax Reimbursement Amendments**

This Bill provides for reimbursement of property taxes.

Discussion: The Sponsor presented the Bill. The House adopted Amendment 1. The amendment changes county “auditors” to county “assessors” throughout the Bill. No discussion ensued.

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### **Bill: 1<sup>st</sup> substitute HB 66 – Ritual Abuse Amendments**

Floor Sponsor:

**UASD Position: Support**

This Bill addresses ritual abuse.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. The House adopted Amendment 1. The amendment deletes the additional training requirement for the Utah Prosecution Council to develop on lines

44-46 and adds language to line 59 stating that the advanced training course must include “identifying indicators of a ritual abuse...in cases of sexual assault”. There was no discussion to the Bill.
