**Bill: 1st substitute HB 81 – Fluoride Amendments** Sponsor: Representative Stephanie Gricius Floor Sponsor: Senator Kirk A. Cullimore **UASD Position: Support** 

This Bill addresses provisions related to water fluoridation and prescription fluoride supplements.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Representative Ward referenced statistics supporting the use of fluoride for better dental health and spoke in opposition to the Bill. Representative Bennion asked how the Bill would interact with existing military fluoride programs. The sponsor clarified that federal law overrides state law in this case, ensuring that those programs would not be affected. Representative Bennion expressed concerns about the Bill. Representative Thurston asked how the Bill would allow pharmacies to interact more closely with patients. The sponsor explained that pharmacies are eager to implement fluoride prescribing programs, with prescriptions determined by DHHS guidelines. Representative Thurston then inquired whether the Bill would not restrict adult use of fluoride. Representative Gricius confirmed that it would not restrict adult use of fluoride. Representative Chevrier spoke in favor of the Bill. Representative Fitisemanu echoed sentiments expressed by Representative Ward, emphasizing fluoride's positive impacts. No further discussion ensued.

This Bill modifies provisions related to probate transfer of personal property by affidavit.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. No discussion ensued.

This Bill modifies the Utah Procurement Code.
