Bill: HB 229 – Transportation Funds Amendments

This Bill amends provisions related to corridor preservation to include fixed guideway public transit facilities for corridor preservation.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. There was no discussion.

Bill: 1st Substitute HB 256 – Municipal and County Zoning Amendments Sponsor: Representative R. Neil Walter Floor Sponsor: UASD Position: Support

This Bill modifies provisions related to the authority of municipalities and counties regarding short-term rentals.

Discussion: The sponsor introduced the 1st Substitute, which was adopted by the House. The substitute simply adds "County" to the title. Representative Fiefia asked the sponsor to define a short-term rental. The sponsor said that it is a property that is rented for less than 30 days. The sponsor sad that rentals that are longer than 30 days are not applicable to the Bill. Representative Bennion stood in support of the Bill but stated that it may not go far enough to solve the problem

being faced by communities with short-term rentals. Representative Shelley also stood in support.
