Bill: SB 25 – Postretirement Reemployment for Emergency Services Workers

This Bill modifies provisions of the Utah State Retirement and Insurance Benefits Act relating to postretirement reemployment.

Discussion: The sponsor presented the Bill. Representative Auxier asked how the Bill affects "double dipping" of benefits. The sponsor said that the Bill is meant to prevent double dipping. It simply allows individuals who retire under the Utah Retirement System to be compensated up to \$15,000 per year as an affiliated emergency services worker without it impacting their state retirement benefits.

Bill: 3rd Substitute HB 38 – Criminal Offenses Modifications
