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### **Bill: 2<sup>nd</sup> Substitute SB 104 – Boundary Line Amendments**

This Bill addresses ground ambulance interfacility transport services.

The new language requires a county or municipality to offer the current 911 ambulance service provider the first right to provide interfacility transports. Additionally, it mandates that counties or municipalities conduct formal reviews of both 911 service providers and interfacility transport service providers every eight years. There was no discussion.
