### **Bill: 1<sup>st</sup> Substitute HB 285 – Water Infrastructure Modifications**

Sponsor: Representative Casey Snider

Floor Sponsor: Senator Scott D. Sandall

**UASD Position: Support**

This Bill addresses funding and planning for water infrastructure.

Discussion: The sponsor said that the changes made in the Senate were technical in nature. No further discussion ensued.

### **Bill: 1<sup>st</sup> Substitute HB 504 – Financial and Conflict of Interest Disclosures by Candidates Amendments**

Sponsor: Representative Lisa Shepherd

Floor Sponsor: Senator Ronald m. Winterton

**UASD Position: Tracking**

This Bill amends provisions related to campaign finance and conflict of interest disclosures.

Discussion: Representative Shepherd presented the Bill and proposed the 1st substitute, which clarifies cross-code references and makes technical changes to ensure consistency with HB 299. Specifically, it adds the word "calendar" when referring to "calendar days" instead of "business days", eliminating the need for a coordinating clause. The substitute was adopted by the body.

### **Bill: 2<sup>nd</sup> Substitute HB 411 – Public Asset Ownership Amendments**

This Bill addresses the state ownership of certain environmental assets.
