Bill: 3<sup>rd</sup> Substitute HB 160 – Professional License Degree Amendments

Sponsor: Representative Stephanie Gricius Floor Sponsor: Senator Chris H. Wilson **UASD Position: Tracking with Concern** 

This Bill modifies licensure requirements.

Discussion: Senator Wilson presented the Bill. There was no discussion.

Yeas: 21 Nays: 0 N/V: 8

Outcome: 3rd Substitute HB 160 passed out of the Senate.

Bill: HB 446 – Great Salt Lake Amendments

Sponsor: Representative Jill Koford Floor Sponsor: Senator Scott D. Sandall

**UASD Position: Tracking** 

This Bill addresses issues related to the Great Salt Lake.

Discussion: Senator Sandall presented the Bill. There was no discussion.

Yeas: 26 Nays: 0 N/V: 3

Outcome: HB 446 passed out of the Senate.

Bill: 3<sup>rd</sup> Substitute SB 207 – Local Impact Mitigation Amendments

Sponsor: Senator Ronald M. Winterton Floor Sponsor: Representative Neil R. Walter

**UASD Position: Tracking** 

This Bill enacts a local impact mitigation tax for oil and gas production.

Discussion: Senator Winterton presented the amendments made in the House. He explained that the State Tax Commission identified an error, which has been corrected, and that the House clarified one of the definitions in the Bill. There was no further discussion.

Yeas: 25 Nays: 0 N/V: 4 Outcome: The Senate concurred with the amendments made in the House.  $3^{rd}$  Substitute SB 207 passed out of the Senate.

Bill: 6th Substitute SB 26 – Housing and Transit Reinvestment Zone Amendments

Floor Sponsor: Representative James A. Dunnigan

**UASD Position: Tracking** 

This Bill amends provisions relating to the Housing and Transit Reinvestment Zone Act.

Discussion: Senator Harper presented the changes made to the Bill, explaining that provisions were added to clarify the HTRZ on the hotel mitigation fund, the city sales tax, and the county sales and use tax. Additionally, the County Auditor, Tax Commission, and Bonding Council made several technical clarifications. There was no further discussion.

Yeas: 21 Nays: 5 N/V: 3

Outcome: The Senate concurred with the amendments made in the House. 6<sup>th</sup> Substitute SB 26 passed out of the Senate.

Bill: 2<sup>nd</sup> Substitute SB 220 – Construction Modifications

Floor Sponsor: Representative Thomas W. Peterson

**UASD Position: Support** 

This Bill addresses construction site storm water runoff controls.

Discussion: Senator Musselman explained that the House amended the Bill to add a carveout for military installations and clarified some language. There was no discussion.

Outcome: The Senate concurred with the amendments made in the House.  $2^{nd}$  Substitute SB 220 passed out of the Senate.

Bill: 3<sup>rd</sup> Substitute SB 336 – Utah Fairpark Area Investment and Restoration District Modifications

Floor Sponsor: Representative Ryan D. Wilcox

**UASD Position: Tracking** 

This Bill modifies provisions relating to the Utah Fairpark Area Investment and Restoration District.

Discussion: Senator Musselman stated that the Bill no longer includes provisions for additional stadiums in the Utah Fairpark Area Investment and Restoration District. An agreement was also reached that the car rental tax would not be collected until a stadium is officially announced. Senator Kwan asked whether the new language affects the minimum occupancy requirement for the stadium. The sponsor clarified that the occupancy number will revert to what was passed last year.

Bill:  $2^{nd}$  Substitute SCR 3 – Concurrent Resolution Supporting Federalism Principles and Utah's Control of its Energy Future

**UASD Position: Tracking** 

This Resolution reaffirms Utah's sovereignty under the principle of federalism and asserts the state's right to determine its own energy policies.

Discussion: Senator Harper presented the substitute, explaining that the Resolution had been revised to place a greater emphasis on energy, along with some other cleanup changes. There was no further discussion.

Outcome: The Senate concurred with the amendments made in the House.  $2^{nd}$  Substitute SCR 3 passed out of the Senate.

Bill: 4th Substitute HB 198 – Highway Expansion Impacts on Signage Amendments

**UASD Position: Tracking** 

This Bill amends provisions related to the relocation of a billboard due to road construction or other highway changes.

Discussion: Senator Johnson presented the Bill. There was no discussion.
